TRIGGERS/INDICATORS: Potential triggers/indicators that may cause a screener to consider conducting a Level One Screen

Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS): These are home and community-based services provided to individuals to support their level of independence in the home and community.

- Inquiries related to LTSS
- Looking for nursing home or assisted living placement
- Person transitioning from hospital or nursing facility to community
- Individual with (ID/DD) or ABI looking for LTSS
- Parent of a child who is in need of LTSS
- Inquiry about Medicaid
- Individual expressing concerns about care at home
- Concerns that a physical or mental disability is interfering with performing daily activities
- Planning for future care
- Recent significant change in circumstance
- Individual with a mental health condition who is looking for LTSS
- When any of the above are identified during a re-determination or re-assessment process with existing clients
